April 1 /2024 This is a new project and the objective of the project is to support all identified children with disabilities (cwds) in 20 villages of Tamulpur block and district. The aim to provide these children, approximately 100-120 in total, With appropriate rehabilitation services and connect them to necessary entitlements. Additionally, we will offer counselling to parents and enhance the capabilities of government front-line workers (Anganwadi workers and Asha Karmis) in early identification of disabilities.

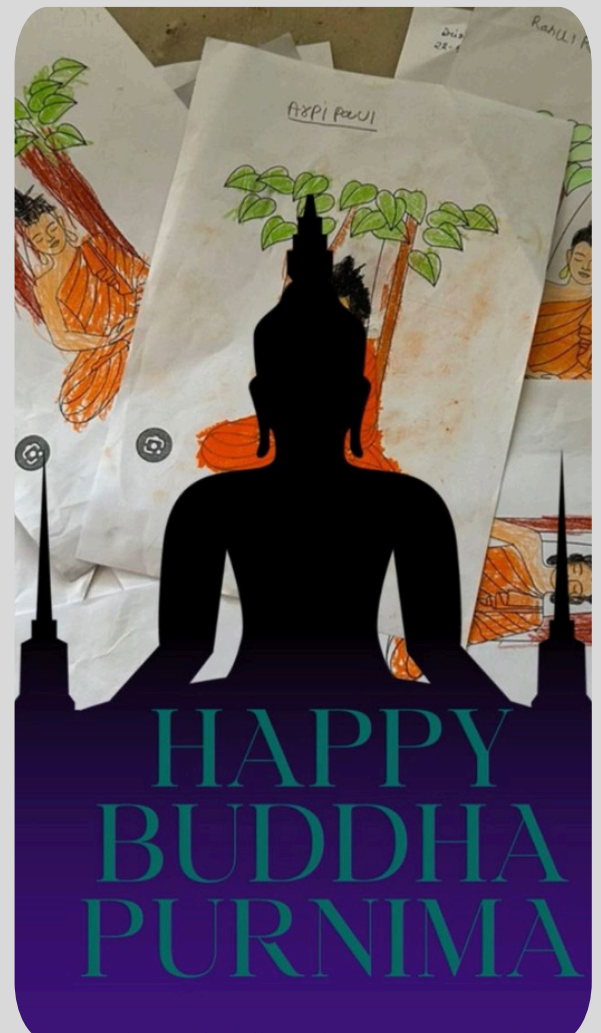
MAY MONTH'S GROUP ACTIVITY
